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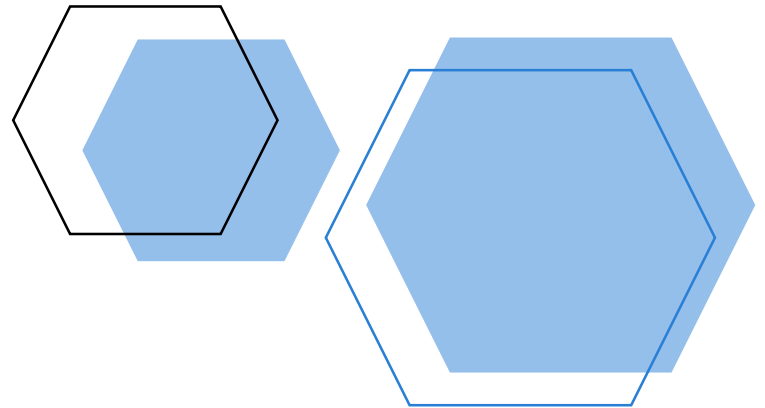


## MISSION

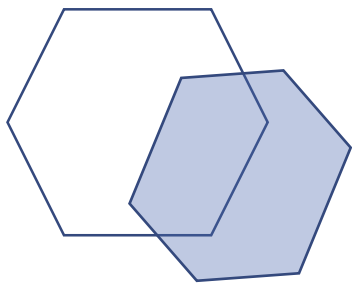
## CRITICAL CORE TRAINING: BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS) FOR PHYSICIANS

## Art Therapy for Kids with Cancer

IMET2000-PAL in cooperation with An-Najah National University Hospital organized two activities in art therapy this month. The first activity on the 20th of April, 2019 was for children with cancer and chronic diseases. On 27th of the same month a second activity was held. It included free drawing with watercolours, where each child could choose his/her own colour to help them reflect their feelings. The workshops included a therapeutic story to develop children's imagination and perception and a drawing diagnostic test and scratched drawing. The children's passion to play and draw was obvious as they explored the art world. About 8 children attended each activity. Ms. Hadeel Alawneh, art therapist, led the activities.
