“Infection Prevention and Control Training: Practical Guidelines for Infection Control in Health Care Facilities”

IMET2000-Pal organised a training event for nursing students, focused on infection prevention and control, in Bethlehem /Qubeibeh branch in Ramallah. 28 nursing students attended the training. The course was led by Mr Fadi Zaben, the head of the General Education Department at IMET2000-Pal. It focused on theoretical and practical aspects of infection prevention and control principles, basic methods of prevention, types of patient isolation, and ways to prevent or reduce the risk of hospital acquired infections.

On the 16th of March 2017, IMET2000-Pal organised training for physicians titled: “The Danger of Antibiotics Misuse and How to Properly Use”. The workshop was attended by 22 physicians and doctors of pharmacy from Al-Makassed Hospital, An-Najah National University Hospital, Istishari Arab Hospital, Caritas Hospital and Birzeit University. The workshop was led by Dr Rabee Odwan -Infectious Disease Specialist/ Al-Makassed & Istishari Arab Hospitals. The training enriched the knowledge of the attendees in the different types of bacteria especially the multi-drug resistant, antibiotics types, principles of its use and closed the training up with the discussion of some clinical scenarios.

Mr Fadi Zaben started his speech by welcoming group members, and then he explained the main pillars of the IMET2000-Pal, fields of interest as well as previous and future projects.
