IMET2000-Pal Organised Training Session for Doctors and Nurses on Advance Cardiac Life

The Department of Continuous Education at IMET2000-Pal and in cooperation with the Ministry of Health organised workshop training for 14 physicians and nurses working in Hebron governmental hospital. The training focused on the principles of the basic emergencies and was titled: "Advance Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Training" according to the American Heart Association (AHA) 2015 guidelines. The workshop was led by Mr. Osaid Rashid, a lecturer at AL-Quds University, and Dr. Salah Itmizi / emergency specialist.



IMET2000-Pal Organised Training for Nursing Students on Infection Prevention and Control

In collaboration with the Palestinian Ministry of Health and as part of our Infection Control Training Program, we organised a workshop on "How to prevent Catheter-associated Urinary Tract Infection (CAUTI) and Surgical Site Infection (SSI)". The workshop was attended by more than 35 doctors and nurses working in intensive care units in Palestine. IMET2000 will continue organising similar workshops to offer training for all those working on this field.
