IMET2000 Supports Undergraduate Health and Medical Students with Partial Scholarships

In a move that reflects the International Medical Education Trust 2000 commitment to supporting medical education and healthcare in Palestine, IMET2000 has launched a programme of partial scholarships specifically aimed at healthcare students who have been affected by the current political situation.

This initiative seeks to provide the necessary support for students to continue their education and contribute to the rebuilding and development of the healthcare sector in Palestine, underscoring the role of education as a foundation for sustainable development and building a better future for all.

IMET2000 provided batches of partial scholarships to support undergraduate medical and nursing students. IMET2000 has sponsored scholarships to 35 students based on academic excellence and financial need from Al Quds University – Abu Dis, Arab American University Palestine – Jenin, An-Najah National University – Nablus and Palestine Polytechnic University – Hebron.

Prof Malik Zaben, CEO of IMET2000, expressed his pride in continuing this programme, saying:

“This programme is not just financial support; it is a real investment in the future of our health sector. Over the programme of its six batches, we granted more than 65 students to complete their academic journey. 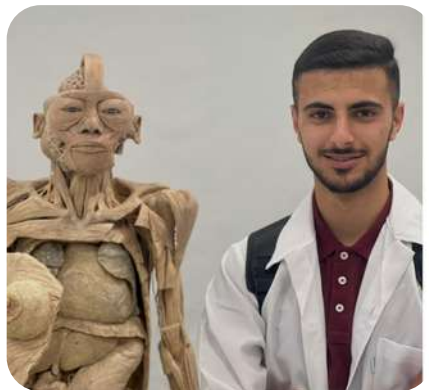

IMET2000 Supports Medical Students with Stethoscopes

IMET2000 Held Four Basic Life Support Training Workshops in November

IMET2000-Pal organised four training workshops attended by 34 doctors and nurses from governmental and private hospitals on:

Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for Healthcare Professionals

The workshops took place at the Arab American University Heart Centre, Friends Medical for Health Creativity Heart Training Site, An-Najah National University Heart Centre, and IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Collaboration with Modern University Collage Heart Centre. These trainings aimed to provide instructions and practical sessions about adult, children, and infant Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for healthcare professionals and Automated External Defibrillation (AED). They were led by certified instructors from American Heart Association (AHA).

IMET2000-Pal Hosts Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Training for Physicians and Nurses

IMET2000-Pal organised two Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Physicians and Nurses workshops to equip healthcare professionals with critical life-saving skills.

First Workshop (11&12 November 2024): Sponsored by IMET2000, this session trained six doctors at Al Amal Hospital, focusing on advanced resuscitation techniques and emergency response.
